Several issues about starting dates, what other Michigan universities do, and when do other schools end their final examinations were discussed.

- 4. Orientation Committee Howard Shapiro has appointed a committee with faculty, staff and administrators to look at issues related to WSU undergraduate orientation. SAC will seek the advice of the Policy Committee on a procedure for one of its members to serve on the Orientation Committee; it was also suggested that there should be student membership on the committee.
- 5. Building Campaign it was brought to the committee statention that there is not a uniform way to disseminate information across campus and building by building. In addition there has been damage to walls when people just tape announcements to them. The members of SAC have agreed to investigate how information is conveyed and report it to the next meeting
