## Charges to FSST 2024-25

- Develop policy recommendations after review of what the university is currently undertaking to ensure sustainability in purchases, construction, and processes/procedures, including trash and recyclables collection in buildings, bioswales in areas around campus, consideration of native plantings rather than small patches of mowed lawn, purchasing of renewably sourced products (carboard, paper, ink cartridges for pens), etc.
- Review issues around university facilities staff responsiveness to flooding, mold, rodent or poor ventilation issues
- Consider that, while the university satisfies the minimum standard for accessibility, should there be a subgroup within FSST or a new Academic Senate ad hoc Accessibility Task Force to: i) identify accessibility issues ii) report to Policy for discussions with Student Senate/Union and administration as appropriate
